### MYP III:

Learning Alliance strongly believes in ensuring that all doors remain open for its students: may they choose to go abroad or stay back in Pakistan for their higher studies. Most of the top universities in Pakistan are accepting IB equivalence as IB MYP is recognized by the **Inter Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC)**, a committee run by the Ministry of Education, Pakistan. However, there are still a few professional colleges (especially the state medical and engineering ones) that require students to have taken Cambridge International Examination (CIE) of Urdu, Islamiyat, and Pakistan Studies in order to obtain an equivalence certificate to gain admission. To this end, the syllabus of CIE Urdu, Islamiyat and Pakistan Studies will be introduced in MYP III and all of these subjects will continue throughout MYP IV and the first term of MYP V till all LA IB MYP students appear for the CIE in October/November 2016.

The syllabus of CIE Urdu, Pakistan Studies, and Islamiyat will continue and students will appear in the CIE in the first term of MYP-V i.e. October/November 2016. Students will be required to choose **ONE** of the three optional subjects being offered in MYP-IV: Design, Arts, & Physical Education. Optional subjects will be offered only if there are at least 5 registrations.

Students will begin work on their Personal Project and complete it by the end of MYP V. **In May- June 2017, students will be required to appear for the MYP (e-assessments) conducted by the IB Board. Their Personal Project will also be moderated.**
